RUSH HOURS (WEEKDAYS)



- 1 Shuttle 919 Trainbus Acadie/Mont-Royal/Namur (±15 min)
- 2 Metro from the Namur station to the Bonaventure station (±20 min)

SHUTTLE 919 - Trainbus Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu

- Service on weekdays during rush hours in both directions
- Departure every 15 minutes
- Use of the reserved lane on rue Jean-Talon, from avenue Victoria to avenue Mountain Sights westbound and from avenue Victoria to rue de Nancy eastbound

TRAVEL OPTIONS




- Line 92 Jean-Talon
 - Departure every 20 minutes
 - Use of the reserved lane on rue Jean-Talon
 - Additional departures during rush hours: 4 westbound and 3 eastbound
- Line 165 Côte-des-Neiges
 - Additional departures: 14 southbound and 6 northbound
 - Use of reserved lanes on chemin de la Côte-des-Neiges and boulevard René Lévesque
- Line 465 Express Côte-des-Neiges
