- 1 Shuttle 964 Trainbus Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu (±15 min)
- 2 Metro from the Côte-Vertu station to the Bonaventure station (±25 min)

SHUTTLE 964 - Trainbus Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu

- Service on weekdays from 5:30 a.m. to 12:45 a.m.
- Travel time of about 15 minutes
- Route synchronized with the departures and arrivals of the rail shuttle
- Use of reserved lanes on rue Grenet during rush hours
- Service with transit priority signals on rue Grenet
- New platform at the Bois-Franc station to pick-up passengers with 3 buses at a time, through all doors

Local public transportation network toward the Côte-Vertu station:


- Line 121 Sauvé Côte-Vertu, addition of 9 departures during the morning rush hours and 7 during the evening rush hour
