* Please note that the shuttle 404 that starts at Grand-Moulin station makes a stop at Deux-Montagnes station. On weekdays, service is available between 4:45 a.m. and 11:30 p.m. On weekends, service is available from 6:30 a.m. on Saturday and 7:30 a.m. on Sunday until 11:30 p.m. The shuttle route ends at the Centre-ville terminal. The route goes along the shoulders of Highways 640 and 13, as well as along the Highway 20 reserved lane.

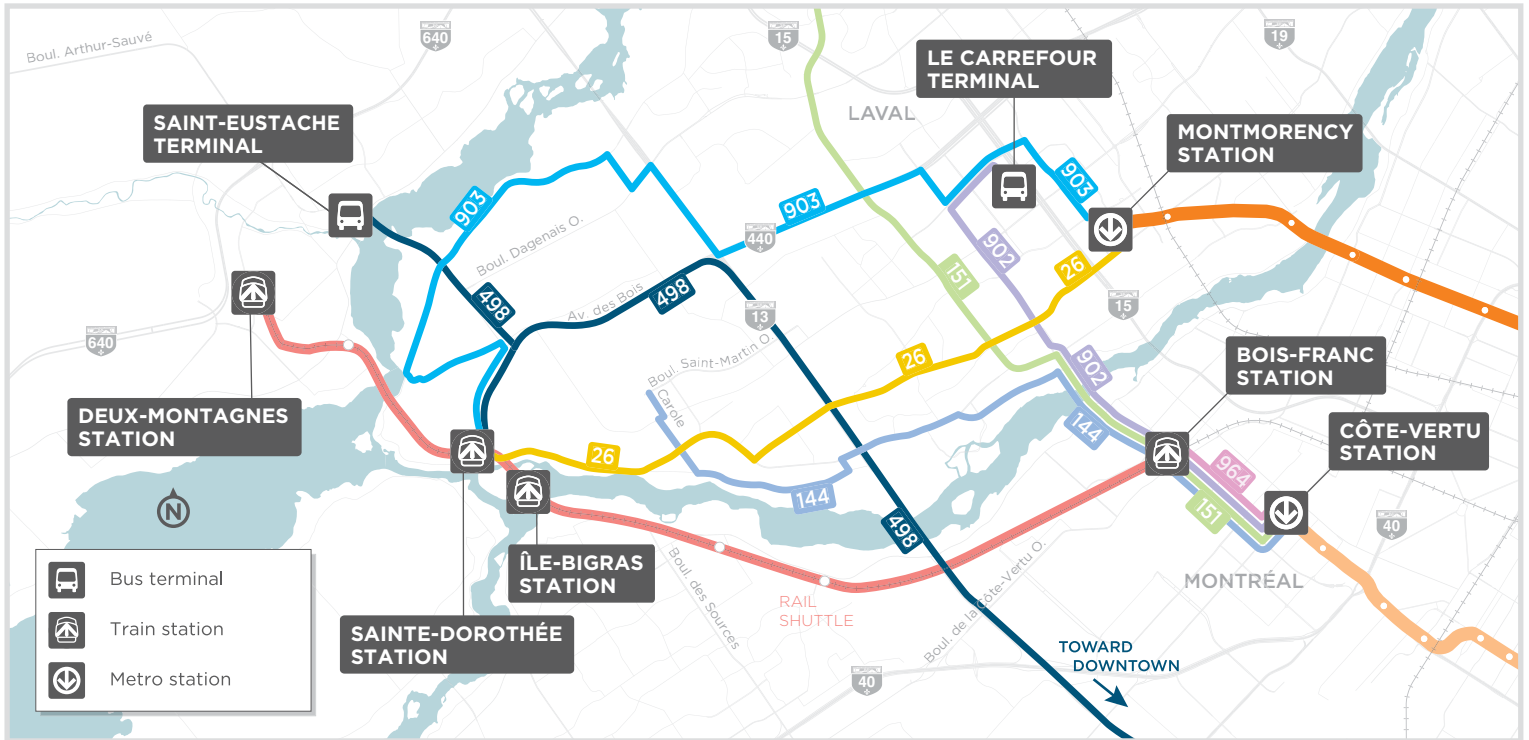

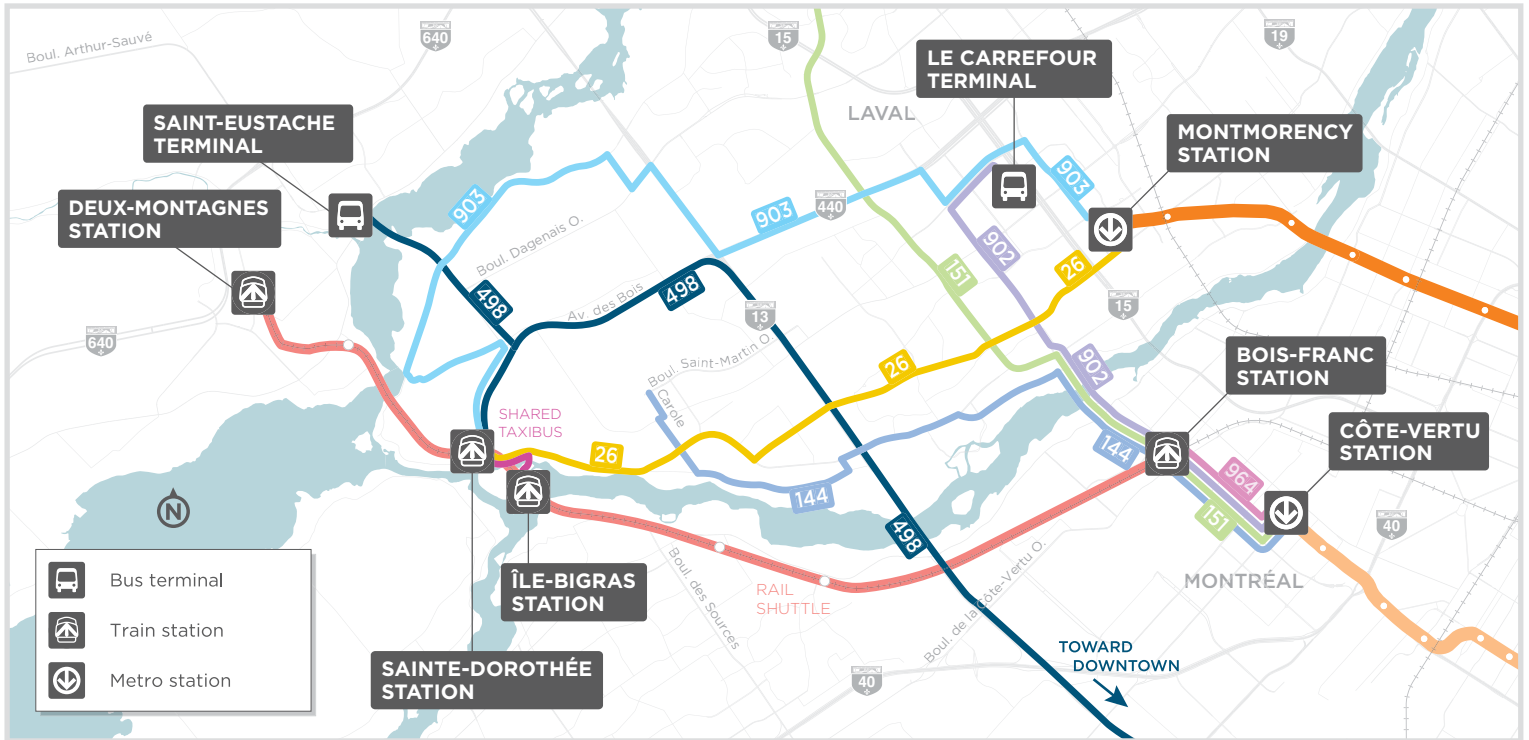

- 4 **Metro** from Côte-Vertu station to Bonaventure station (± 25 min)
