


SHUTTLE 964 - Trainbus Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu

- Service on weekdays from 5:30 a.m. to 12:45 a.m.
- Travel time of about 15 minutes
- Route synchronized with the departures and arrivals of the rail shuttle
- Use of reserved lanes on rue Grenet during rush hours
- Service with transit priority signals on rue Grenet
- New platform at the Bois-Franc station to pick-up passengers with 3 buses at a time, through all doors

PREFERRED ROUTE

RUSH HOURS (WEEKDAYS)

1 Rail shuttle from the Sainte-Dorothée or Île-Bigras station to the Bois-Franc station (±15 min)

- 2 Shuttle 964 Trainbus Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu (±15 min) (See reverse side for more details)
- **3** Transfer between different transportation modes (±15 min)
- **Metro** from the Côte-Vertu station to the Bonaventure station (±25 min)

TRAVEL OPTIONS

IMPROVED SERVICE¹

Toward the Côte-Vertu station

- Line 144 from Sainte-Dorothée to the Côte-Vertu station (±45 min)
- Line 151 from Sainte-Rose to the Côte-Vertu station (±55 min)
- Line 902 between the Le Carrefour terminal and the Côte-Vertu station (±40 min)

Toward the Montmorency station

- Line 26 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency station² (±40 min)
- Line 903 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency station² (±55 min)

 between the Côte-Vertu and Bonaventure stations

SERVICE MAINTAINED



OFF-PEAK AND WEEKENDS

- Line 26 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency terminal² (±30 min)
- Line 903 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency terminal²(±50 min)
- Shared taxibus line T26 with a transfer to line 26 (±35 min)


